Experience:

- Five years of experience in the medical analysis department clinical pathology and Histopathology as well.

Clinical pathology:

- The Oncology Institute receives no less than 200 cases daily. I am responsible for drawing blood samples and conducting all medical tests, whether related to the Biochemistry department, such as liver and kidney function tests, Hematology (complete blood counts, coagulation tests, blood cultures, and preparing blood films if necessary), and Parasitology (urine sample analysis and cultures). I also handle hormone tests and tumor markers like Alf, CA15.3, among others. Additionally, I participate in initiatives launched by President Abdel Fattah ElSisi, including prostate cancer screenings by conducting PSA tests for more than 300 people.
- Regarding the **histopathology department**, I process samples and prepare wax blocks, cut them on the microtome, and then stain and mount them. I also prepare cytology samples when necessary, using the centrifuge, spreading them, then staining and mounting them. I work with Immunohistochemistry devices, programming samples, performing cleaning, and conducting SISH tests. I also participate in President El-Sisi's initiatives for colorectal and lung cancer screenings, where I receive, process, cut, mount, stain, and mount the samples
